

Supervisory Priorities

Key Points:

- Enhance Supervision to be more effective and efficient by focusing on material financial risks
- Review & Reform Capital Framework to ensure that it is appropriately designed and calibrated
- Review Regulations & Information Collection to ensure that this framework remains viable
- Improve the Bank Application Process so that requirements and standards are transparent and timelines for action are clear
